

2011 Frankenmuth Forest Archers Application For MSC Camp Wilderness

Camp Wilderness is a three-day camp that teaches boys and girls the Michigan DNR Hunter's Education and International Bow Hunter Education Program (IBEP). Upon completion of this camp the youth will have been taught archery, firearms, first aid and other skills that will prepare them for the hunting experience.

Things you should know before applying:

- You must be between the ages of 10 and 15 on your birthday in 2011.
- The camp dates are July 8 - 10, 2011 and children will need to arrive at the camp at 8:00 a.m. sharp on Friday morning.
- The kids will be taught archery, firearm and hunter safety and will be shooting bows and guns during camp.
- Classes included in the camp are: First Aid/Survival, Firearm Safety, Practical Shooting, When/Where to Shoot, Treestand Safety, Use of Ground Blinds and compass'.
- If your child has their own bow, they should bring it to camp along with six arrows. **NO** other weapons are allowed in camp.
- The registration fee covers everything that the child will need for the weekend, however, there is a camp store that the kids are allowed to visit. \$5-10 should be sufficient to cover anything at the store.
- Other leisure activities that the kids can take part in, include: Swimming, Canoeing, Volleyball and Campfire.

If you would like to be one of the kids from our club to be sponsored to attend camp this year, please fill out the application and return it to a member of the club no later than March 14, 2011. The Frankenmuth Forest Archers Board will be holding a meeting to select the three winners and we will announce them on Monday, March 28, 2011 during the awards dinner.
